Purpose

In partnership with the Cerritos Presbyterian Church, the City of Artesia will be awarding up to 3 high school seniors or college students, a \$1,000 academic scholarship to the college, university, or trade/technical school of their choice. The City of Artesia encourages all students to pursue higher education and find their passion. The Cerritos Presbyterian Church is passionate about helping the local community, especially the Artesia youth. The goal of this scholarship is to encourage and support students begin their journey in higher education.

This year's theme for its essay is *"After completing college, my contribution to Artesia will be"*

Scholarship Applicant Criteria:

- Applicant must be a 12th grade high school student or a current college student
- Applicant must be a resident of the City of Artesia
- Applicant plans to attend a college, university or trade/technical school in Fall 2018

or

Applicant is a current college student registered for Fall 2018

All applicants will need to submit:

- Completed scholarship application
- Proof of residence in the City of Artesia (utility bill, copy of identification, etc.)
- Official academic transcript
- All applicants must submit an essay addressing *"After completing college, my contribution to Artesia will be..."* Essay should be at minimum two pages.

All applications must be submitted by 5pm on Monday, May 7, 2018
