City of Artesia's Summer Food Service Program Begins

On Thursday, June 13, the City of Artesia began its Summer Food Service Program for children 18 and under who are out of school for the summer months. The Program, which is run through the California Department of Education Nutrition Services Division (CDE), provides free breakfast and lunch to children.

The City operates the Program out of AJ Padelford Park in North Artesia, and serves an average of 30 children for breakfast and 100 for lunch each day throughout the summer. Breakfast is served from 9:30 AM – 10:30 AM and lunch is served from 12:30 PM – 1:30 PM. This Program is one of many the City runs throughout the summer for schoolchildren.
