Construction on Norwalk Boulevard Street Improvement Project to Begin July 22

On Monday, July 22, hard construction will begin on the Norwalk Boulevard Street Improvement Project. This project, made possible by a nearly \$2 million grant from the State's Alternative Transportation Program, will make numerous improvements to the entire length of Norwalk Boulevard within the City of Artesia, including new bike lanes, improved sidewalks, all new pavement and landscaped medians, monument signs, and more.

Beyond making Norwalk Boulevard a more pleasant street to drive, these improvements will make streets safer for drivers, pedestrians, and cyclists, and will make it easier for residents to walk or bike instead of drive along this important corridor.

In April, City Council approved plans for the project and in June, a contract was awarded to the Griffith Company to complete the project according to the City Council-approved plans. Work on the project is expected to be complete around the end of 2019.
