Scheduled Tree Trimming for District 5 Set for July

Starting next month, the City of Artesia's tree maintenance contractor West Coast Arborists will begin scheduled trimming for trees in tree maintenance District 5. District 5 is bounded by 183rd Street to the north, Pioneer Boulevard to the west, the City's boundary with Cerritos to the east, and 195th Street to the south.

This scheduled trimming for District 5 is in accordance with the three-year trimming cycle implemented by the City in 2017. "Following this schedule ensures that trees are kept in good health and that all areas of the City are serviced regularly, maintaining a strong tree canopy for the community," said Councilmember Ali Taj.

Completing trimming for District 5 this fiscal year will mean that all City-owned trees will have been trimmed since 2017. Recognizing the importance of a healthy tree canopy, the City will continue to take care of its trees and to find opportunities to add more trees for the benefit of Artesia residents.
