



# Jiggling Jellyfish

## Supplies Needed:

- Paper Plate (9 inch)
- Cupcake Liners
- Paint or Markers/crayons
  - Glue or tape
  - Scissors
- Pen/marker (optional)
- Googly Eyes (optional)


**Step 1:** Cut a plate in half and have child decorate the outside to make the jellyfish body. You can use crayons, markers, dot markers, or stickers if paint is not available. Set aside to dry.

Step 3



**Step 2:** Flatten a cupcake liner and have child cut it to make the jellyfish tentacles. They should start by cutting at the outside edge and spiral inwards. The ridges on the cupcake liner give the jellyfish tentacles a cool texture.

Step 4



**Step 3:** Glue or tape the tentacles to the inside of the plate (unpainted side).

**Step 4:** Draw a face on the painted side of the plate. (Optional step: Add googly eyes to the jellyfish.) Now you can hang your jellyfish up or let the kids wave it around in the air like it is swimming in the ocean. The tentacles will jiggle around.
