City of Artesia to Not Issue Street Sweeping Fines Until Further Notice

As part of its precautionary changes to City operations and response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, the City of Artesia began not issuing fines for street sweeping violations on March 17th and will not do so until further notice.

As the City of Artesia seeks to keep streets as clean as possible especially during this time, street sweeping is still taking place and the City asks for residents' cooperation in moving their vehicles wherever possible. However, given the current Los Angeles County and State of California Safer at Home orders, no citations with fines are being given out during this period.
