# California Has Lifted Most COVID-19 Restrictions

The State of California and the Los Angeles County Public Health Department have lifted almost all COVID-19 related restrictions as cases and hospitalizations have declined significantly over the last few months. Currently, vaccinated individuals only have to wear masks in very limited settings like public transportations and healthcare facilities, or if a business requires masking for all customers. Unvaccinated residents must continue to wear their masks in almost all settings. # The City of Artesia is Opening!

The City of Artesia has taken significant measures to protect the public and staff as the COVID-19 outbreak has persisted over the year, including offering services virtually throughout this time. In recognition that some services require in-person interaction, the City opened to the public for limited in person services by appointment only in August. With the improving public health situation this spring, the City of Artesia is excited to announce that City operations will be fully reopened to the public by July 1st.

Starting on June 21st, the public will be able to come to City Hall or other City facilities to receive help or meet with staff without an appointment, subject to health screenings and all applicable State and County protocols. Indoor and outdoor recreation opportunities will also be expanding as long as State and County guidance allow it. In July, the City Council will return to meeting in person in the City Council chambers with the public allowed to be present.

Since April, the City of Artesia has been working with partner organizations to bring community vaccination clinics to Artesia to make getting vaccinated against COVID-19 even easier! In April, the City hosted two community vaccination events at Artesia Park in partnership with the LA County Sheriff's Department, and two more have followed since at A.J. Padelford Park in conjunction with The Medicine Shoppe Pharmacy in Artesia. All residents age 12 and up are eligible to get vaccinated and it's now easier than ever so make sure to get your shot!

## City Rebate Programs Available for Residents & Businesses



The City of Artesia offers several rebate programs for Artesia residents to make it easier for them to keep their homes safe and clean, obtain Internet access, start businesses, and more. All of the below applications are currently open for applications. **Home Security and Alarm Rebate Program:** As part of its efforts to improve public safety in the community, the City of Artesia offers a Home Security and Alarm Rebate Program for Artesia homeowners. Under this program, Artesia homeowners who purchase an eligible new home alarm system can receive a rebate of up to \$250 for the purchase price of the system. Eligibility requirements and a link to the online application form are available on the City website.

**Graffiti Removal Program:** The City of Artesia's Graffiti Removal Program assists homeowners by offering graffiti removal services and supplies to those who frequently deal with graffiti placed on their property. The Graffiti Removal Program offers two types of services for property owners in the City. The options include the receipt of free graffiti removal supplies (paint or removal chemicals) or removal by the City for a nominal fee. Eligibility requirements and a link to the application form are available on the City website.

**Home Internet Rebate Program:** The City of Artesia offers the Home Internet Rebate Program to qualifying Artesia residents that obtain reduced price internet subscriptions from an internet provider. All major internet providers in Artesia offer a reduced price service for qualifying low-income customers and residents are advised to contact a provider to get information on a particular service. Through this program, the City hopes to make it easier for low-income households to afford internet access during this time. The City will rebate up at \$180 over 12 months toward the cost of a qualifying internet service. Learn more at [www.cityofartesia.us](http://www.cityofartesia.us).

**Business License Rebate Program for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities:** As part of its goal to grow the City's business community and expand access to business opportunities in Artesia, the City has created the Business License Rebate Program for Individuals with Developmental Disabilities, which will rebate the cost of a business license plus up to \$20 in administrative processing fees for business owners with developmental disabilities. Only businesses with annual gross receipts up to \$1,000 will be eligible for a rebate under the Program. For the purposes of the Program, the City requires proof of either eligibility for services or enrollment in services with the Harbor Regional Center. Applicants to the Program will need to first obtain a business license and pay the applicable fees and then submit an application to City staff to be eligible to receive a rebate. The online service request tool the City offers is a tool for the community to report issues like fallen tree branches, graffiti, and illegal dumping. This

system is easy to use and makes it easy for City staff to track and follow up on requests.

Residents who report issues through the City's online system see prompt results. Most requests are addressed within 3 days, and all residents who report an issue through the system will be contacted by the City regarding the status of their request. Since November 2018, the City has addressed over 450 requests through the system.

Please include as many details as possible with you request in order to assist City staff in quickly addressing the issue. City staff is committed to outstanding customer service and addressing all concerns as promptly as possible.

# Be Mosquito Safe This Summer



Make sure you're prepared for mosquito season! All mosquitoes need is water, usually dirty, stagnant water, to breed and create hundreds or thousands of new mosquitoes in a short period of time. This is why we need to do everything we can to keep stagnant water off of our property. In Los Angeles County, including Artesia, the Greater Los Angeles County Vector Control District (GLACVCD) works to control mosquito populations and prevent the spread of

mosquito-borne illnesses, along with those of similar insects that carry disease that can harm humans. GLACVCD works quickly to respond to service requests to keep mosquito populations down.

In Artesia, you can submit a service request to the GLACVCD if you are having mosquito issues on your private property or if you see a standing water problem elsewhere. It's as easy as visiting [www.glacvcd.org/vector-information/service-request-form](http://www.glacvcd.org/vector-information/service-request-form) and filling out the details. The City works with GLACVCD each year to share information on mosquito issues and to have potential problem areas inspected and addressed quickly.

- KEEP STANDING WATER OFF YOUR PROPERTY. COMMON CULPRITS INCLUDE:**
- Clogged gutters
  - Pools, ponds, fountains, & hot tubs
  - Rain barrels, old flower pots, buckets, and cans
  - Waste, old tires, or any other container
  - Keep doors and windows tightly sealed and make sure screens fit tightly to keep mosquitoes out of your house
  - Use insect repellent when outdoors
  - Wear long-sleeved shirts and pants when outside during mosquito season

## Enroll in California's Earthquake Early Warning System!

Natural disasters, like earthquakes, happen unexpectedly and can create major disruptions that last long after the event is over. By being prepared and planning ahead, Artesia residents can quickly take life-saving actions to keep them safe in an earthquake. It's important for all households and businesses in the City of Artesia to prepare a disaster plan; identify safe spots to take cover in places where they live, work, and play; familiarize themselves with emergency escape routes; develop a communication plan; and have an emergency supply kit readily available.

To ensure all Californians are earthquake prepared, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) developed Earthquake Warning California, which is the nation's first statewide earthquake warning system that provides several seconds of warning to mobile device users in the area before shaking occurs. Earthquake Warning California offers no-cost earthquake warning resources, including:

- **MyShake App** A mobile app that can be downloaded for mobile devices at no cost from Google Play the Apple App Store. App location services must be set to "always on" so that ground sensors can alert those in the nearby area when shaking is detected.
- **Android Earthquake Alerts** An earthquake warning system available to any new or updated Android devices that uses that same technology as the MyShake App.
- **Wireless Emergency Alerts (WEAs)** Text-like messages from the government during emergency situations. This includes: Presidential, Imminent Threat (fire, earthquake, floods, etc.), and AMBER alerts.

Earthquake Warning California resources are designed to notify users to quickly take protective action such as to drop, cover, and hold on. These earthquake warning tools can help protect lives and prevent damage to properties in the areas hardest hit during an earthquake. During serious shaking situations, individuals may be knocked down to the ground, so sheltering prior to shaking is the prudent thing to do. What you need to know about

## BUSINESS RECYCLING LEGISLATION

Businesses that generate a certain amount of solid waste are subject to various recycling laws in California.



### MCR: Mandatory Commercial Recycling | Assembly Bill 341 (AB 341)

This bill requires jurisdictions to meet the diversion goal of 75% by 2020 resulting in businesses who generate 4 or more cubic yards of solid waste to either:

- Participate in a recycling program with their local waste hauler
- Donate, sell and/or sell self-haul materials to a recycling facility



### MORe Mandatory Organics Recycling | Assembly Bill 1826 (AB 1826)

This bill requires businesses to separate their food scraps and green waste for recycling. AB 1826 builds on the success of the mandatory commercial recycling program established by AB 341. All businesses with 2 or more cubic yards of solid waste per week must either:

- Participate in a recycling program with their local waste hauler
- Donate, sell and/or self-haul materials to a recycling facility
- Compost organic materials



### Reducing Short-Lived Climate Pollutants | Senate Bill 1383 (AB 1383)

In September 2016, Governor Brown signed SB 1383 establishing methane emissions reduction targets in a statewide effort to reduce emissions. In accordance to this law, all local jurisdictions must provide organic waste collection service to all residential and commercial generators by January 1, 2022. This will help divert this material from landfills. Organic waste includes food scraps and green waste such as landscape and pruning waste.



### On Premises Collection Bins | Assembly Bill 827 (AB 827)

This bill requires businesses to provide customers with public-facing recycling and organics recycling collection bins to collect recyclable material generated from products purchased on the premises. The bins or containers must be visible, easily accessible, and clearly marked with signage indicating appropriate recyclable material.
