City of Artesia to Hold Free Academies for Residents and Businesses

The City of Artesia will hold a free Academy Program designed to inform the community about the functions of their City, the services that are offered, and the opportunities available to get involved. The Academy series will be offered one day a week for six consecutive weeks, to both residents and businesses. The curriculum will cover a variety of topics of interest tailored for each group.

The Resident Academy will be held from 6:00 -7:00 p.m. on Tuesdays, beginning September 28 through November 2. Topics will include information on City maintenance, parks and recreation programs, and public safety. The Business Academy will provide information about the process for opening a business in Artesia, business resources available, and opportunities to get involved. Classes will be held on Thursdays, from 10:30 – 11:30 a.m. from September 30 through November 4.

The academies will be held at the Artesia Community Support Center, located at 18163 Pioneer Boulevard and has limited capacity. Registration is free and available at www.cityofartesia.us on a first-come, first-served basis. The City will follow L.A. County Health Officer Orders regarding COVID-19 safety protocols, which include the use of a mask in an indoor setting, regardless of vaccination status.
