City of Artesia Seeking Donations for Scholarship Program

The City of Artesia would like to partner with civic groups, churches, or businesses in the community to fund the City's Scholarship Program. The City is seeking to raise \$3,000 to award up to three \$1,000 scholarships to seniors in high school planning to attend college or trade school. Artesia residents currently attending college, university, or trade school, are also eligible. To be eligible, students must reside in Artesia, have a minimum overall GPA of 3.0, and be active in the community. All applicants are required to submit an essay with their application entry.

Due to the unprecedented challenges of COVID-19, the program was placed on hold in 2020. The City would like to continue to offer this Scholarship Program to support the scholastic advancement of students in the community. The City of Artesia would like to award \$3,000 this year, to college students currently enrolled in the fall semester, or those currently enrolled in trade school. The City will provide administrative support for the scholarship and will give sponsors recognition in articles printed in City publications and on the City's website. All scholarship recipients will be invited to be recognized at a City Council meeting. Scholarship sponsors will also be invited to attend to be acknowledged. Organizations serving Artesia or businesses in the city, interested in partnering with the City of Artesia to fund (either partially or fully) this scholarship, are asked to call City Hall at 562-865-6262, Ext. 261 for more information.

This program has provided financial assistance to help make a difference for students pursuing a higher education or seeking to develop expertise in a trade or vocation over the past three years.
