Bulky Item Collection Events

The City of Artesia will offer two Bulky Item Collection Events this Summer to give Artesia residents the opportunity to dispose of any unwanted large household items. The events will be held on July 30th and September 17th as follows:

July 30th - A.J. Padelford Park - 11870 169th Street

September 17th - Artesia Park - 18750 Clarkdale Avenue

Residents can dispose of items such as damaged furniture, appliances, mattresses, or even excessive green waste. The events will be held from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (or until the bins are completely filled), and are held on a first-come, first-served basis. Attendees will be required to provide proof of residency and some form of identification (State ID or Driver's License). For more information, please call 562-865-6262, Ext. 262.

What are Bulky Items?

Items that cannot properly fit into your trash carts are considered bulky items and require a special pick up. CR&R provides four free bulky item pickups (up to four items for each scheduled pickup) per year to all residential customers.

Large Items:

Sofa beds, couches, tables, chairs, mattresses, box springs, patio furniture, etc.



White Goods:

Washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, air conditioners, microwaves etc.



Electronic Waste:

Computers, televisions, monitors, printers, cell phones, etc.



Non-Acceptable Items Include:

Construction and demolition material such as wood, asphalt or concrete won't be accepted. Automotive parts, batteries or hazardous waste are not permitted.

City Adopts Ordinance to Deter Catalytic Converter Theft



The Artesia City Council recently amended the Artesia Municipal Code to make the possession of an uninstalled catalytic converter a violation in the City. Catalytic converter theft is one of the fastest rising crimes in California and nationwide. Artesia is one of the first cities to enact such a law. This law took effect on May 14th.

Catalytic converters have become highly sought items by thieves due to their value in metals, the ease in which the part can be removed from a car, and the

difficulty in tracing a particular part back to the owner. Thieves sell them on the recyclables market for a high dollar value, without any requirement to provide proof of rightful ownership. Additionally, there is currently no State, or Federal legislation requiring individuals to provide proof of ownership to law enforcement if found in possession of an uninstalled converter. Victims of these thefts are left to suffer costly repairs, and the unease of having their property violated.

The passage of this Ordinance by the City Council makes the possession of any uninstalled catalytic converter unlawful in the City of Artesia. It also makes it unlawful for anyone to knowingly falsify information or documentation intended to show valid proof of ownership. Each of these will constitute as separate violations and misdemeanors subject to a punishable fine of \$1,000 dollars or by jail time for up to six months, or both. These provisions were adopted to deter these types of thefts in the community, and give the City of Artesia and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, the legal authority needed to better protect its citizens.

Celebrating Independence Day is a tradition for Americans. This is a fun day in which people gather to celebrate; many using fireworks. The City encourages residents to celebrate safely by only using "Safe and Sane" fireworks during their festivities.

"Safe and Sane" fireworks are allowed in the City, to support the efforts of non-profit organizations. They can be discharged beginning June 28th through July 4th, from noon to 10 p.m. Only "Safe and Sane" fireworks are permitted; all others are considered illegal.

Illegal fireworks are dangerous, can be traumatic for people that suffer from Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD), disturb pets, and can cause fires. Those that discharge illegal fireworks in Artesia will face a fine up to \$2,000.

Any type of fireworks is prohibited from being discharged at City parks or any other City property. Illegal fireworks can be reported by calling the Lakewood Sheriff's Station at 562-623-3500 (for non-emergency).

The City's 4th of July Celebration will offer a spectacular fireworks show, conducted by professionals. You won't want to miss it! (See back cover for details.)

NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR DISPOSAL OF ORGANIC WASTE IN GREEN WASTE CARTS

The City of Artesia and CR&R Incorporated (CR&R), the City's contracted hauler, have developed a program for source-separated collection and processing services that will launch this Summer. This program will bring the City into compliance with SB 1383, which is a State law that requires all cities to implement an Organic Waste Recycling Program for residents, to prohibit organics and food waste from being disposed in landfills. This new requirement aims at converting organic waste (which will include food scraps) into compost or other recyclable material to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

The City and CR&R have negotiated new rates reflecting pass through and program compliance monitoring costs that will be effective July 1, 2022. Existing residential green waste carts will become organics carts that can accept both yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps.

Starting in June, CR&R will place a decal on existing green waste carts to announce the transition to the new Organics Recycling Program which becomes effective July 1, 2022. The sticker will list the items that will be accepted in that cart. The recycling guide below has been updated to reflect the new program, indicating what items can be disposed of in the colored waste containers. 
