# Bulky Item Collection Event

The City of Artesia will offer one final Bulky Item Collection Event this fall for Artesia residents. The event will be held on September 17<sup>th</sup> from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (or until the bins are filled) at Artesia Park, located at 18750 Clarkdale Avenue. Residents are invited to dispose of unwanted items such as damaged furniture, appliances, mattresses, or excessive green waste. Participants will be requested to provide proof of residency and some form of identification (State ID, Driver's License, utility bill, etc.). The event is first-come, first-served. Residents are welcomed to make repeated trips to dispose of unwanted items, as there is no limit to the number of items that can be disposed. For more information, call 562-865-6262, Ext. 262.

## What are Bulky Items?

Items that cannot properly fit into your trash carts are considered bulky items and require a special pick up. CR&R provides four free bulky item pickups (up to four items for each scheduled pickup) per year, to all residential customers. To schedule your free pickup, call CR&R at 866-949-9694.

### Large Items:

Sofa beds, couches, tables, chairs, mattresses, box springs, patio furniture, etc.



### White Goods:

Washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, air conditioners, microwaves etc.



### Electronic Waste:

Computers, televisions, monitors, printers, cell phones, etc.



### Non-Acceptable Items:

Construction and demolition material such as wood, asphalt, or concrete. Automotive parts, batteries, or hazardous waste.

## Dispose of Hazardous Waste Safely

The County of Los Angeles is partnering with the City to offer the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on September 17<sup>th</sup>, on the Elaine Avenue side (near the Library) of Artesia Park. LA County residents can conveniently dispose of products labeled toxic, poisonous, combustible, corrosive, irritant, or flammable, for free. By law, these products must be properly recycled or disposed of at a hazardous waste facility or collection event, such as this one.

Examples: antifreeze, batteries, cleaning supplies, TVs, and cell phones

## Pet License Amnesty Period

The City of Artesia has partnered with the County of Los Angeles Department of Animal Care and Control (DACC) to provide a pet license amnesty period to Artesia residents who are dog or cat owners. This provides City residents an opportunity to have any late fees on a pet license waived. This applies to both late fees for renewals or new licenses purchased between August 1 through October 31. ## How to help a lost pet

If you come across a lost pet in the community, there are a few things that you can help do to increase the possibility of reuniting the pet with their rightful owner. The County of Los Angeles Department of Animal Care and Control (DACC) offers the following suggestions on their website:

1. If the pet is sick or is aggressive, please call the DACC at 562-940-6898.
2. Check for a tag on the pet's collar for contact information. If no tag is found, take the lost pet to a shelter or veterinary clinic to be scanned for a microchip.
3. Post flyers in the neighborhood where the pet was found.
4. Use community apps like Nextdoor and Ring to post a message with a picture of the lost pet.
5. Use social media platforms such as Facebook to post a message. Use lost pet pages and groups as well.



The City of Artesia contracts with the DACC for animal care services. The facility that serves the community of Artesia is located at 11258 South Garfield Avenue, in the City of Downey. The DACC will post photos of lost pets brought to their facility on its website, hoping to reunite them with their owners. ## Be a Good Neighbor: Clean Up After your Dog

Owning a dog provides wonderful benefits for pet owners. Enjoying a leisurely stroll through the neighborhood with your dog, is one of the great experiences pet owners can enjoy. However, if the dog's waste ends up on sidewalks, public areas such as parks, or worse yet, on private property, it can become unpleasant for others in the community.

Dog waste can become a nuisance in a variety of ways:

1. It can be unsightly to others and carry unpleasant smells.
2. It is bad for the environment. If dog waste ends up in storm drains, it can pollute stormwater.
3. It carries diseases which can be transmitted to other dogs or humans.

The City of Artesia reminds dog owners that cleaning up after your dog and keeping sidewalks, parks, and other public areas clean, helps beautify the City. Maintaining a beautiful community helps improve the quality of life for everyone. Picking up after your pet is simple, and it is part of being a responsible pet owner. The City encourages you to be considerate towards others and help keep Artesia clean.

# NEW REQUIREMENTS FOR DISPOSAL OF ORGANIC WASTE

Effective January 1, 2022, every city in California was required to implement organic waste recycling and comply with other requirements under Senate Bill 1383. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings such as landscape and pruning debris. CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's contracted waste hauler, will recycle organic waste by converting it into soil amendments at its composting facility. This will help keep the community's organic waste out of landfills.

On July 1, 2022, existing green carts are now organics carts that can accept kitchen food scraps. Please contact CR&R at (866) 949-9694 to have an organics cart delivered if you currently do not have one, or with questions regarding the new disposal requirements. ## What materials can go into the organics cart?

**From your yard:** Grass clippings, leaves, weeds, prunings, flowers, and other yard waste.

**From your kitchen:** Fruit, bread, fish, meat, vegetables, dairy, fats, oil, and grease.

**Items NOT accepted in organics carts:**

Recyclables (plastic, glass, metal), styrofoam, pet waste, palm fronds, and trash.

Compostable bags are optional and available at local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. You can reuse containers around your home to help you contain and carry your kitchen food scraps to your organics cart. A reusable container with a lid is ideal, this can include using an empty food tub or similar containers (such as ice cream, potato salad, laundry detergent pods, etc.), especially if it has a handle. Drain excess liquid first or add shredded newspaper or paper bags to absorb excess moisture in your container.
