Meet Artesia's New City Manager

The Artesia City Council is pleased to announce the appointment of Aldo E. Schindler as its new City Manager. The Council took action at its October 10th City Council meeting to approve a contract with Schindler, concluding the City's ten-month search to fill the top administrative position in the organization.

Mr. Schindler comes from the City of Moreno Valley, where he held the position of Assistant City Manager, overseeing all facets of land development and their city utility. He brings over 28 years of experience in local government, which includes 13 years of executive management with project management experience in Economic Development, Planning, Housing, and Workforce Development. He has served communities in the local region throughout his career, including the cities of Long Beach, Whittier, and most recently the City of Downey, where he last served as Deputy City Manager.

Mike Egan, who has served as Artesia's Interim City Manager since January, called it a great hire for the City. "Aldo is well known and well regarded in the


Gateway Cities region. His strength in Community Development and knowledge of both local and regional issues are just what the City needs."

Mr. Schindler is a Southern California native. He earned a Bachelor's degree in Political Science from San Diego State University, and holds a Master's degree in Public Administration from the California State University, Long Beach. He and his wife of 24 years have three children who have grown into successful young adults. He is also an avid mountain biker, and when not working you will most likely find him on the local trails.

"I'm very excited to serve the community of Artesia, and lead staff in implementing the vision of the City Council," said Schindler. "As a resident of the area, and frequent visitor to Artesia, I look forward to working with the City's residents and businesses."

As Artesia's City Manager, Mr. Schindler serves as the City's Chief Executive Officer and is responsible for directing the activities of City employees. He is also responsible for enforcement of all City codes, ordinances, and regulations, the conduct of all financial activities, and the efficient and economical performance of the City's operations.

Recycle your Christmas Tree

CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's franchised waste hauler will offer convenient pick up of Christmas trees for recycling. Organic waste, like Christmas trees is no longer allowed in landfills under Senate Bill 1383. Recycling Christmas trees provides benefits to the environment. Decomposing organic waste creates greenhouse gases that contribute to climate change events, such as hotter summers and extreme droughts. Recycling Christmas trees into wood chips or mulch that can be used for landscaping or gardens, is much better for the environment.

CR&R will collect Christmas trees from December 26 through January 6, for residents with cart service. Multi-family residents who dispose their trash in dumpsters should work with their site managers or property owners, to have their Christmas tree removed.

To prepare a Christmas tree for recycling, please do the following:

- Remove tree stand, tinsel, ornaments, and decorations.
- Trees over 6 feet, should be cut in half and placed at the curb. Trees under 6 feet should be placed in the organics cart.
- Flocked trees will be accepted, but are not recyclable because the flocking contains chemicals and materials that are not allowed in organics recycling.

Residents may use their bulky item service if they are unable to recycle their tree during this collection period. The bulky item pick-up program allows four bulky item pick-ups free of charge per calendar year. Call 866-949-9694 to see if you qualify for a bulky item pick-up.



Organic Waste Recycling

California laws changed earlier this year. Every City in California is now required to have an organic waste recycling program and comply with other requirements under Senate Bill 1383, to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris. Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags are optional and available at local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's contracted waste hauler, will help keep this waste out of the landfills and will convert it into soil amendments at its composting facility.

FREE FOOD SCRAPS PAIL

The City of Artesia will provide free kitchen food scraps collection pails to interested residents. This container can be kept in the kitchen to help collect food scraps and used to gather food waste.



This smaller pail can then be emptied into the green organics cart on collection day. Call City Hall at 562-865-6262 to request a pail. One pail per address will be provided. Proof of residency will be required (State I.D. with current address or utility bill).

Artesia Expands its Tree Canopy Coverage



The City of Artesia has been planting trees throughout the community as part of its urban forest planning and expansion efforts. This project is made possible with funds from the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE) Urban Forestry.

Since September, the City has planted approximately 90 trees along Elaine Avenue, Horst Avenue, Rendova Street, Grayland Avenue and Devlin Avenue. An additional 70 trees will be planted along Devlin Avenue, 183rd Street, Ashworth Street, and Grayland Avenue.

Trees provide a benefit to public health, by helping reduce pollution, providing shade and cooling our neighborhoods, and decreasing the amount of stormwater runoff, among other benefits. The City has planted over 280 trees since February of 2021 with these funds.

City Seeking Community Sponsors for Scholarship Program



The City of Artesia would like to partner with civic groups, churches, or businesses in the community to raise at least \$3,000 for the City's Scholarship Program, which supports the academic advancement of Artesia residents.

Business License Renewals A New Year, A New License!

Did you know that all businesses operating in the City of Artesia, including rental properties, home businesses, and contractors, must obtain a business license in order to operate legally in the City. Licenses are issued for one calendar year, and must be renewed annually. The City automatically sends out renewals in December. Business license renewals are due on January 1st, and must be renewed no later than January 31st to avoid late fees.

A new business license application must be completed if there are changes to ownership, the business name, or if there is a change to the business location.
