Free Smoke Alarms and Installation

Working smoke alarms can cut the risk of death from home fires in half. It is important to ensure all smoke detectors are working at home. The City of Artesia is partnering with the American Red Cross to Sound the Alarm! Through this program, Artesia residents can sign up for free smoke alarms and installation. The only requirement to be eligible is to register! Red Cross volunteers will do installations in Artesia on Saturday, March 18 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. during a Sound the Alarm event. Pledge to keep your family safe, and schedule a free smoke alarm installation.

**VOLUNTEERS
NEEDED!**

Volunteers are needed to help install smoke alarms on March 18 during Artesia's Sound the Alarm event. No experience is needed to participate. Youth ages 16 and older do not need a parent or guardian present. Youth ages 13 to 15, must have a parent or guardian accompany them at the event. A parental consent form (provided on site) is required for all youth volunteers ages 13 to 17. The American Red Cross provides the needed information and all the tools needed to help with the smoke alarm installations. To volunteer visit RedCross.org/LAHomeFire.



Submit a Request for Service Online

The City of Artesia provides an online service request system through which residents can quickly report issues, such as potholes, malfunctioning street lights, fallen tree branches, graffiti, illegal dumping, and other concerns. Residents who make a request through the online system see prompt results.

SPRING AWARDS 2023

Nominate a property that helps keep Artesia Beautiful!

The City of Artesia is pleased to announce nominations can now be made for the Spring Beautification Awards. The Beautification and Maintenance Commission, which promotes the City's efforts to maintain Artesia as an attractive community, will help select the properties that do an outstanding job helping beautify Artesia neighborhoods through the upkeep of their home or business.

Don't miss the opportunity to nominate someone who does an outstanding job, or self-nominate your own home or business! Nominations will be accepted through 5 p.m. on Thursday, May 11. Entry forms are available on the City's website at www.cityofartesia.us.

All entries must include digital photos of the property, which will be used for judging by the Beautification and Maintenance Commission. The photos should highlight the best features of the property/landscaping/etc. for the entry category selected. The categories available for entry are as follows:

Residential Entries

Landscape Beautification Award: This award will recognize homes that exhibit exceptional pride of ownership through well-maintained and exceptional landscaping of their property. This includes an attractive landscaping design of the front yard and parkway, a clean and well-maintained exterior, and overall good curb appeal.

Sustainable Landscape Beautification Award: This award will recognize homes that exhibit exceptional pride of ownership through the use of water conservation practices as part of their landscaping design. This includes the use of drought-tolerant or native plants, water-friendly irrigation systems, and energy-efficient or solar lighting.

Business Entries

Storefront Beautification Award: This award will recognize businesses that contribute to the overall beautification of the community by demonstrating exceptional pride of ownership through the outstanding maintenance of their property. This includes an attractive façade, storefront, a clean and well-maintained exterior, and an attractive landscaping design.

Sustainable Landscape Beautification Award: This award will recognize businesses that contribute to the overall beautification of the community by demonstrating exceptional pride of ownership through the use of water conservation practices as part of their landscaping design. This includes the use of drought-tolerant or native plants, water-friendly irrigation systems, and energy-efficient or solar lighting.

To be considered for an award, all nominated properties are required to be in compliance with the City's building codes. The City will award up to five recipients in each category, and will invite all selected recipients to be recognized at a City Council meeting.

Help Keep Artesia a Beautiful City



The City of Artesia partners with CR&R (the City's contracted waste hauler) to offer a Bulky Item Collection Program which provides residential customers, four FREE bulky item pick-ups per calendar year. At any time, account holders can contact CR&R with the number and description of their items to schedule a pick-up. Up

to four bulky items can be scheduled at a time. To schedule a bulky item pick-up call 866-949-9694. Calls should be made 48 hours in advance of your regular collection day.

Multi-family residences (such as apartments or condominiums) should contact their property owner or property manager about proper disposal of bulky items through CR&R.

Did you know?

Items that are too large to fit into trash carts are considered bulky items and require special pick-up.

Proper Disposal of Unwanted Items

Illegal dumping creates visual blight throughout the City of Artesia and negatively affects our community. Often residents who are unaware of the proper disposal process for large, bulky items resort to leaving unwanted items on the sidewalk. Artesia residents can help make their neighborhoods look their best. The City partners with CR&R Inc. Environmental Services (CR&R) to offer residents a variety of resources and events to properly dispose of large, bulky items (such as furniture and appliances) which do not fit in the regular collection cart. These include:

Subscribing to Regular Trash Collection Service

The Artesia Municipal Code requires each owner of residential, commercial, and industrial property in the City have solid waste and recyclable materials collection service for each premise (Section 6-2.109). While some cities automatically enroll properties into its solid waste collection service through its public utilities division, the City does not, as it does not provide public utilities. Property owners, their agents, or tenants must contact CR&R, the City's franchised solid waste hauler, to subscribe to trash service for their properties. This can be done by calling 866-949-9694. Four free bulky item pick-ups per year are offered with residential service.



The City of Artesia recently eliminated the practice of stopping waste collection services due to non-payment and will instead place delinquent accounts on the property tax roll. This process was established to allow for the continued collection of trash service, while providing the City a mechanism for payment of delinquent accounts when the owner or occupant does not voluntarily pay.

Participating at a Bulky Item Collection Event

The City of Artesia will hold its first Bulky Item Collection Event of the new year. The event will be held from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. on March 25 at A.J. Padelford Park, located at 11870 169th Street. Artesia residents can clean out unwanted bulky items in their household and properly dispose of them free of charge. Bulky items include mattresses, desks, household appliances, and other large items that do not fit in your trash cart. No registration is required. Participants simply need to provide proof of residency to participate. For more information, please call 562-865-6262, Ext. 262.





COMPLIMENTARY TAXI SERVICE

The Artesia Express program provides free taxi rides to Artesia residents who age 60 years or older or are disabled. Registration is required prior to using the service. Although assistance is available during office hours, a dedicated staff member will be available Monday – Friday from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Service area includes the Artesia city limits, plus areas bound by: Rosecrans Ave. (north), E. Carson St./Lincoln Ave. (south), Valley View Rd. (east) and Bellflower Blvd.

(west). Hours of transportation service are from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. (5 days a week). For location information, call 562-860-3361. Each participant's trip allotment is 50 one-way trips each month, with a four-trip daily limit to ensure all participants have equal access.

Participants must make a reservation at least 20 minutes in advance of their desired pick-up for same day service. Scheduling trips well-ahead of time is highly recommended. Call 877-356-1230 for reservations.
