City of Artesia Property Tax

Did you know that the City of Artesia is considered a “no/low property tax City?” This means the City had no property tax or a low property tax in place prior to the passage of Proposition 13.

The passage of statewide Proposition 13, imposed a cap on the total property tax rate that could be imposed without voter approval. Further, existing taxes collected throughout each county statewide were proportionately compressed down to 1%, establishing a base amount for each agency. However, all agencies without a tax levy in place prior to Proposition 13, received very little to nothing under this formula. State legislation was passed to rectify this, as more than 30 cities were impacted. This was rectified through Tax Equity Allocations – a reallocation of property tax revenue in each county to impacted cities. The City of Artesia receives a portion of the revenue generated through LA County’s 1% tax.



City’s revenue from property tax is
\$0.000659
for every dollar collected.

Revenue to the City:

The City of Artesia receives \$0.000659 of revenue for each dollar collected for property tax. The amount remitted to the City from the county varies based on the total amount collected. Property owners in Artesia pay property taxes on the assessed value of their property, as determined by the Los Angeles County Assessor. The Auditor Controller is responsible for allocating property tax revenue to the local entities within the county, such as the City of Artesia.

Artesia Earns Tree City USA Designation



The City of Artesia has earned recognition as a 2022 Tree City USA! The Tree City USA designation honors the City's commitment to effective urban forest management.

The Tree City USA program provides communities with a four-step framework to maintain and grow their tree cover. The program is sponsored by the Arbor Day Foundation, in partnership with the US Forest Service and National Association of State Foresters. Through this partnership, the organizations aim to inspire communities to plant trees, properly care for trees, and celebrate trees.

The City has and cares for 2,561 trees, with 109 unique species in Artesia's tree inventory. The number of trees in Artesia is above average for cities of its size. The City has planted 418 trees since 2021, with a grant from CALFIRE, most recently with the help of many community volunteers who helped beautify the community. The City of Artesia is committed to preserving a greener Artesia!

One Free Hour of Parking in City's Downtown Parking Lot!

To access a free hour of parking in the City's parking lot, simply go to the ticket kiosk, select "one hour free," print out the ticket, and place it on your vehicle's dashboard. New Food Waste Requirements



California laws now require every city in the State to have an organic waste recycling program. Cities must now comply with this and other requirements under Senate Bill 1383, to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris.

Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags are optional and available at local

retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's contracted waste hauler, will help keep this waste out of the landfills and will convert it into soil amendments at its composting facility.

Free Pail for Food Scraps

The City of Artesia will provide free kitchen food scraps collection pails to interested residents. This container can be kept in the kitchen to help gather food scraps, which are now required to be emptied in the green organics cart. Call City Hall at 562-865-6262 to request a pail. One pail per address. Please note that proof of residency will be required (State I.D. with current address or a utility bill). Trash Service Requirements in Artesia

The City's Municipal Code requires property owners in Artesia to have solid waste and recyclable materials collection service (Section 6-2.109). While some cities automatically enroll properties for service, Artesia does not. Property owners, their agents, or tenants, must contact the City's franchised waste hauler, CR&R Inc., to subscribe to trash service. This can be done by calling 866-949-9694.

Important Change for Delinquent Accounts

The City of Artesia recently eliminated the practice of stopping waste collection services due to non-payment, and will instead place delinquent accounts on the property tax roll. This process was established to allow for the continued collection of trash service, while providing the City a means for payment of delinquent accounts, when the owner or occupant does not voluntarily pay.
