Road Improvements

Pioneer Signing and Striping Project

The City restriped Pioneer Boulevard between 183rd Street and 186th Street in July 2023. The project improved traffic flow and safety by creating dedicated right and left turn lanes for northbound traffic, and aligned southbound traffic lanes at 183rd Street.

Gridley Road Improvements

In partnership with the City of Cerritos, new slurry seal was installed on Gridley Road, between 183rd Street and South Street. Additional work included sidewalk, curb, driveway, and median improvements. The cities were also able to coordinate efforts with Southern California Gas Company, who made improvements to the gas lines along this stretch of road.



Upcoming Neighborhood Street Improvements



166th Street Improvement Project

The City of Artesia has joined the City of Norwalk, and the City of Cerritos for the 166th Street Improvement Plan; with the City of Norwalk serving as the lead agency. This project will provide road improvements along 166th Street, between Pioneer Boulevard and Norwalk Boulevard. The new striping plan will improve safety on this street for the residents that live in this area and those that frequently travel through this segment of the City. The project includes a Road Diet, which is common on arterial highways to reduce traffic and increase safety and mobility. The Federal Highway Administration states that Road Diets result in a crash reduction of 19-47%.

The new striping plan will include:

- Parking along 166th Street
- Easier turns in and out of side streets on 166th Street

- Bicycle lanes on both sides of the street
- Painted center median crossover lane with left-turn pockets

Pavement Rehabilitation Project

The City has allocated \$1.9 million in road maintenance funds from the State for upcoming residential street improvements that will help maintain the pavement of streets in need of repair. Seven roads in the City were approved to undergo rehabilitation. The alley between Norwalk Boulevard and Ibex Avenue will also be repaired by upgrading the asphalt road to concrete. Construction for this project is expected to begin this Winter. Call City Hall at 562-865-6262 for more information.

Artesia Transit

The City operates an electric bus service that allows free transit around Artesia, at no cost. The City's free fixed route transit service runs a continuous loop around the City with 12 stops, to offer convenient access to parks, shopping centers, and the downtown district. The City expanded hours of service, to add Tuesdays and Wednesdays from April 4 to June 30, due to a surplus of transportation grant funds restricted to transit service. Over 400 additional riders rode the bus on these expanded days of service. Due to the demand, the City is currently evaluating the ability to expand services permanently. The City will hold its last Bulky Item Collection Event of the year on September 16. The event will be held from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. at Artesia Park, located at 18750 Clarkdale Avenue. This event offers Artesia residents the opportunity to clean out unwanted items in their household and properly dispose of them free of charge. Bulky items include mattresses, desks, and household appliances, which can be hard to dispose of. E-Waste will be accepted at this collection event. Examples of items that can be collected include laptops, speakers, cell phones, and fax machines. No registration is required to participate in this event. Participants simply need to provide proof of residency, by providing some form of identification such as a State ID, Driver's License, or utility bill. The City of Artesia recently recognized six community members for their selection as award recipients of the Spring Beautification Awards. Three recipients received the Landscape Beautification Award in appreciation of their efforts to maintain an attractive landscaping design, well-maintained landscaping, and an overall good curb appeal. One recipient received a Sustainable Landscape Beautification Award for maintaining an attractive landscape with water conservation practices and drought-tolerant features in their design.

The business recognition was awarded to Bhindi Jewelers located at 18508 Pioneer Boulevard, and Yantra Kitchen located at 18511 Pioneer Boulevard. Opening a Business In Artesia?



Follow these helpful tips to get your businesses started and to avoid potential issues Before signing a lease or purchasing property, check the following with City Hall:

- Allowed use of the property/zoning
- Building permit history records
- Outstanding or pending code violations
- Measure V Tax requirements
- Check with City Hall prior to starting any construction.
- Obtain at least three bids when hiring a contractor, architect, or designer.


Hire a reputable general contractor or trade specific contractor, and make sure they have a current business license, state license, and are bonded.

If you need building plans, hire a reputable architect, and make sure they have experience working with cities, and a state license.

- If cost is an issue, hire a reputable designer (a person that can design without a state architect's license).
- Make sure the designer has a current business license, and experience working with cities.

When you are ready to host your Grand Opening, call City Hall to see if a Temporary Use Permit is required.

When opening a new business it is important to know who you are leasing from. Don't be pressured to sign a lease right away. Reputable landlords will have consistent pricing that does not expire tomorrow. It is also important that you are allowed to inspect the unit and have access to a floor plan, to ensure it matches what you are seeing. Otherwise, the work may be unpermitted.



Don't

- Sign a lease without knowing the City's zoning, permits, or building condition.
- Sign a lease prior to getting the City's input regarding the proposed business.
- Start exterior or interior construction work without first checking with the City.
- Make the final payment to a contractor, architect, or designers, until you verify with the City that all work has been completed and is approved.



Red Flags

- A landlord who doesn't want to sign a lease with a contingency clause.
- A location that says "newly renovated" but there are no permits for the space filed with the City.
- Contractors or anyone who suggests doing work without getting City permits.



CO-EXISTING WITH COYOTES

Coyote sightings in City neighborhoods have become increasingly common. While the City does not handle or remove coyotes directly, it does keep track of sightings and encounters. Residents can report coyote sightings through the City's online Service Request system by visiting www.cityofartesia.us and selecting "Report a Concern." For further assistance, sightings and incidents can also be reported to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife at apps.wildlife.ca.gov/wir or by phone at 562-596-3885.

Problem coyotes and incidents should be reported to Los Angeles County Animal Care and Control at 562-940-6898.

Residents are reminded that a few simple actions can help minimize conflicts between residents, pets, and coyotes. If you encounter a coyote, remember to make yourself appear as big as possible and be loud! Stand tall with your arms overhead, hold your ground, and never run. It is crucial not to feed coyotes as this can encourage aggressive behavior. Remove ripe garden vegetables and fallen fruit, and store pet food indoors. Ensure that garbage and compost containers are tightly sealed. Take other preventive measures such as adding motion sensing lighting to deter coyotes. By taking a few simple actions and staying vigilant, we can keep pets, property, and ourselves safe. Help Meet Organic Waste Requirements

California laws now require every City in the State to have an organic waste recycling program. Senate Bill 1383 aims to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris.

Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags can be used (are optional) and are available to purchase from local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. Food scraps pail are still available at City Hall to help residents separate food scrap waste. Please visit City Hall to pick up a pail. The City's contracted waste hauler, CR&R, helps keep organic waste out of the landfills by converting it into soil amendments at its composting facility.


