Creative Action to Address Graffiti



Faced with the escalating dilemma between a rise in graffiti and vandalism along with a lack of prosecution against offenders, the City adopted an Ordinance to hold the parents and guardians of minors who commit acts of graffiti financially responsible. Under the new municipal code, if a minor is found to be responsible for causing graffiti in the City, then their parent or guardian may be administratively cited \$250 for a first violation, \$500 for a second violation, and \$1000 for each subsequent violation. By holding parents and guardians responsible for the actions of their minor dependents, the City hopes to create deterrence by creating a system of accountability and also providing indirect justice to victims of graffiti by imposing sanctions against acts of vandalism.

Pardon our Dust! Major Repairs are in progress on Artesia Roadways!



The City broke ground on major street repairs on February 29, 2024. These streets include:

1. 186th Street between Gridley Road and Pioneer Boulevard;
2. Alburdis Avenue between 183rd Street and the Dead End;
3. Arline Avenue between 183rd Street and the Dead End;
4. 185th Street between Alburdis Avenue and the Dead End;
5. Corby Avenue between 184th Street and 187th Street;
6. 184th Street between Alburdis Avenue and Corby Avenue;
7. 167th Street between Pioneer Boulevard and the Dead End; and
8. The alley between Ibox Avenue and Norwalk Boulevard

These streets were evaluated and found to be in need of rehabilitation as part of the City's 2021 Pavement Management Plan. All of the streets are receiving new pavement, which will improve driving conditions and prevent pot holes and pavement cracking from forming. The City of Artesia is also repairing

sidewalk segments that are experiencing major uplifting, and installing ADA compliant curb ramps at important intersections and making drainage repairs to allow storm water to drain more effectively and prevent ponding at several locations.

Construction is expected to continue until June 2024. In the meantime, the community's patience is greatly appreciated. Be sure to stay updated on this project, and all upcoming street improvement projects, by following the City's social media channels.

Organic Waste Recycling

Every City in California is required to have an organic waste recycling program and comply with other requirements under Senate Bill 1383, to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris. Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags are options and available at local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's contracted waste hauler, will help keep this waste out of the landfills and will convert it into soil amendments at its composting facility.

The City received \$75,000 from CalRecycle for SB 1383 Local Assistance grant funds. This money will be used to enforce and support SB 1383, a law that requires things like recycling organic food waste and improving recycling to reduce pollution. The funds will be used for things like buying containers for organic waste, paying for educational materials, and covering staff time for enforcing SB 1383.

FREE FOOD SCRAPS PAIL

The City of Artesia will provide free kitchen food scraps collection pails to interested residents. This container can be kept in the kitchen to help collect food scraps and used to gather food waste.

This smaller pail can then be emptied into the green organics cart on collection day. Call City Hall at 562-865-6262 to request a pail. One pail per address will be provided. Proof of residency will be required (State I.D. with current address or utility bill).
