Safe neighborhoods, well-maintained streets and parks and a wide variety of activities for seniors, youth and families are all a big part of maintaining property values – which residents have told us are important to them. The City is actively working to maintain streets, parks, sheriff response, and other City services and programs for our residents.

The City strives to repair our streets and fill potholes in Artesia. Before this year’s rainy season, independent engineers rated over one-third of Artesia’s streets as “poor” or “very poor” and their condition has worsened with this winter’s rains. It will be less expensive to repair the streets now than to wait until later.

Artesia residents prioritized the following City services:

- Maintaining 911 emergency response times
- Repairing streets and potholes
- Maintaining gang prevention programs for youth
- Cleaning and maintaining public areas
- Maintaining sidewalks, curbs, gutters, and street lighting
- Maintaining safe routes to schools
- Maintaining crime prevention programs involving thefts and burglaries

Artesia Recognized by Arbor Day Foundation



TREE CITY USA®

The City obtained Tree City USA recognition by fulfilling all four requirements of the program: maintaining a tree board or department, having a tree care ordinance, dedicating an annual community forestry budget of at least \$2 per capita, and hosting an Arbor Day observance and proclamation.

The Tree City USA program is sponsored by the Arbor Day Foundation, in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service and the National Association of State Foresters.

Major Repairs completed on Artesia Roadways!



The City of Artesia broke ground on major street repairs on February 29, 2024. These streets included:

- 1. 186th Street between Gridley Road and Pioneer Boulevard;
- 2. Alburdis Avenue between 183rd Street and the Dead End;
- 3. Arline Avenue between 183rd Street and the Dead End;
- 4. 185th Street between Alburdis Avenue and the Dead End;
- 5. Corby Avenue between 184th Street and 187th Street;
- 6. 184th Street between Alburdis Avenue and Corby Avenue;
- 7. 167th Street between Pioneer Boulevard and the Dead End; and
- 8. The alley between Ibex Avenue and Norwalk Boulevard

All the streets received new pavement, which improved driving conditions and prevented potholes and pavement cracking from forming. The City of Artesia also repaired sidewalk segments that experienced major uplifting and installed ADA compliant curb ramps at important intersections. These repairs improved safety and mobility for all Artesians!

Finally, the City made drainage repairs to allow storm water to flow more quickly and efficiently to storm drains and prevent ponding at several locations in the project area.

Sidewalk Improvements



As part of the City's commitment to enhancing pedestrian safety, the City of Artesia is launching the first phase of our Sidewalk Replacement Program. The project will address some of the most critical hazards at 45 locations in the City. Over 6,000 square feet of sidewalks will be replaced to ensure our residents have safer, more accessible pathways. Expect construction to begin in late Summer, and stay tuned for updates as we extend this project to other areas of the City over the next several years.

The event is first-come, first-served. Residents are welcomed to make repeated trips to dispose of unwanted items, as there is no limit to the number of items that can be disposed. For more information, call 562-865-6262, Ext. 262. Seniors, individuals with disabilities, and residents requiring pickup services can arrange to have up to four bulky items collected.

The second Bulky Item Collection Event is coming this summer for Artesia residents. The event will be held on June 15th from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. (or until the bins are filled) at Artesia Park, located at 18750 Clarkdale Avenue.

What are Bulky Items?

Items that cannot properly fit into your trash carts are considered bulky items and require a special pick up. CR&R provides four free bulky item pickups (up to four items for each scheduled pickup) per year, to all residential customers. To schedule your free pickup, call CR&R at 866-949-9694.

Large Items:

Sofa beds, couches, tables, chairs, mattresses, box springs, patio furniture, etc.



White Goods:

Washing machines, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, dishwashers, air conditioners, microwaves etc.



Electronic Waste:

Computers, televisions, monitors, printers, cell phones, etc.



Dispose of Hazardous Waste Safely

The County of Los Angeles is partnering with the City to offer the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on June 15th, on the Elaine Avenue side (near the Library) of Artesia Park. LA County residents can conveniently dispose of products labeled toxic, poisonous, combustible, corrosive, irritant, or flammable, for free.

By law, these products must be properly recycled or disposed of at a hazardous waste facility or collection event, such as this one.

Examples: antifreeze, batteries, cleaning supplies, TVs, and cell phones

Non-Acceptable Items:

Construction and demolition material such as wood, asphalt, or concrete. Automotive parts, batteries, or hazardous waste are also prohibited. **NO FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION**
