# Letter from the City Manager

Dear Artesia Resident,



The City hopes this message finds you well and enjoying the summer as we enter the Fall, which will include a Presidential Election. We encourage all of our residents to be full participants in the democratic voting process, which includes Artesia's regularly scheduled General Municipal Election.

Artesia's November 5th General Municipal Election ballot is the same day as the federal election. In addition to choosing national, state and county representatives, Artesia voters will also have the opportunity to select two City Councilmembers.

There will also be two local measures on the Municipal Election Ballot:

Measure AAA the Artesia Public Safety and City Services Measure, a  $\frac{3}{4}\%$  local sales tax designed to maintain general City services such as 911 emergency response, crime prevention programs involving thefts/burglaries, neighborhood sheriff patrols, safe routes to schools and youth gang prevention programs.

In deciding whether to place Measure AAA on the ballot, the City conducted two community surveys and engaged the community. Residents identified street repair as a top priority. Prior to this year's rainy season, independent engineers had rated over one-third of Artesia's streets as "poor" or "very poor." It has gotten worse after last winter. Measure AAA funding could be used to repair streets and fill potholes.

Additionally, Measure I is a ballot initiative proposed by National Ready Mix (a cement company located in Artesia) which if enacted would amend the City's approved Artesia Boulevard Specific Plan. If Measure I passes, and voter approval is required for any major modification to the Specific Plan, then that process could add more time and costs to development projects. That is because elections only occur periodically, and they cost money to prepare for and hold.

# Artesia Transit



The City operates an electric bus service that provides free transit service around Artesia at no cost. The City's free fixed route transit service runs a continuous loop around Artesia with 12 stops, to offer convenient access to parks, shopping centers and the downtown district.

Service operates Tuesday through Saturday from 8AM to 5PM. Ridership has increased each year the service has been provided, with a 4% increase over the last year. The

transit service is funded by Proposition A, which is a grant fund which is provided to the City strictly to fund public transportation services and cannot be used for other purposes.

## Bus Shelters

The City is replacing all bus shelters within the City limit. The current shelters are over 20 years old and will be replaced with brand new shelters this winter with grant funds. The shelters will include solar powered light fixtures, a new bench, and a new trash receptacle. These shelters will facilitate travel on bus lines operated by Artesia Transit, Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Agency, Orange County Transportation Authority, Long Beach Transit, Norwalk Transit System, and Cerritos on Wheels.



## CO-EXISTING WITH COYOTES

Coyote sightings in City neighborhoods have become increasingly common. While the City does not handle or remove coyotes directly, it does keep track of sightings and encounters. Residents can report coyote sightings through the City's online Service Request system by visiting [www.cityofartesia.us](http://www.cityofartesia.us) and selecting "Report a Concern." For further assistance, sightings and incidents can also be reported to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife at [apps.wildlife.ca.gov/wir](http://apps.wildlife.ca.gov/wir) or by phone at 562-596-3885.

Problem coyotes and incidents should be reported to Los Angeles County Animal Care and Control at 562-940-6898.

Residents are reminded that a few simple actions can help minimize conflicts between residents, pets, and coyotes. If you encounter a coyote, remember to make yourself appear as big as possible and be loud! Stand tall with your arms overhead, hold your ground, and never run. It is crucial not to feed coyotes as this can encourage aggressive behavior. Remove ripe garden vegetables and fallen fruit, and store pet food indoors. Ensure that garbage and compost containers are tightly sealed. Take other preventive measures such as adding motion sensing lighting to deter coyotes. By taking a few simple actions and staying vigilant, we can keep pets, property, and ourselves safe. # Help Meet Organic Waste Requirements

California laws now require every city in the State to have an organic waste recycling program. Senate Bill 1383 aims to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris.

Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags can be used (are optional) and are available to purchase from local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. Food scrap pails are still available at City Hall to help residents separate food scrap waste. Please visit City Hall to pick up a pail. The City's contracted waste hauler, CR&R, helps keep organic waste out of the landfills by converting it into soil amendments at its composting facility.



The Artesia Spring Beautification Awards Program recognizes the efforts of the City's residents and businesses to promote sustainability and create beautiful landscapes and storefronts that enhance the attractiveness of the City.

There are four categories of awards: Residential Landscape Beautification, Residential Sustainable Landscape, Business Storefront Beautification, and Business Sustainable Landscape. The Beautification and Maintenance Commission oversees the program and finds and nominates businesses and residents for the awards.

The City of Artesia recognized seven residences and four businesses as award recipients for the 2024 Spring Beautification Awards. One winner per category is displayed above, with four recipients honored for Residential Landscape Beautification, three for Residential Sustainable Landscape, one for Business Storefront

Beautification, and three for Business Sustainable Landscape.

The Beautification Awards Program recognizes residents and businesses for outstanding property maintenance. The Beautification and Maintenance Commission, who promotes the City's efforts to maintain Artesia as an attractive community, serves as the judging committee for this program. The Beautification program will resume in Spring 2025.


