

# Recycle Christmas Trees

CR&R Environmental Services, the City's franchised waste hauler, will offer convenient pick up of Christmas trees for recycling. Organic waste, like Christmas trees, is no longer allowed in landfills under Senate Bill 1383. Decomposing organic waste creates greenhouse gases that contribute to climate change events, such as hotter summers and extreme droughts. Recycling Christmas trees into wood chips or mulch that can be used for landscaping or gardens, is much better for the environment.

CR&R will collect Christmas trees from December 26 through January 7, for residents with cart service. Multi-family residents who dispose of their trash in dumpsters should work with their site managers or property owners to have their Christmas trees removed.

To prepare a Christmas tree for recycling, please do the following:

- Remove tree stand, tinsel, ornaments, and decorations
- Trees over 6 feet, should be cut in half and placed at the curb. Trees under 6 feet should be placed in the organics cart.
- Flocked trees will be accepted, but are not recyclable because the flocking contains chemicals and materials that are not allowed in organics recycling.

Residents may use their bulky item service if they are unable to recycle their tree during this collection period. The bulky item pick-up program allows for up to four free pick-ups per calendar year, with a maximum of four items per pick-up.

These fully electric vehicles will replace older gas-powered trucks, reducing emissions and supporting the City's goal of transitioning to a greener future.

# Opening a Business In Artesia?

Follow these helpful tips to get your businesses started and to avoid potential issues. Before signing a lease or purchasing property, check the following with City Hall:

- Allowed use of the property/zoning
- Building permit history records
- Outstanding or pending code violations
- Measure V Tax requirements
- Check with City Hall prior to starting any construction.
- Obtain at least three bids when hiring a contractor, architect, or designer.

Hire a reputable general contractor or trade specific contractor, and make sure they have a current business license, state license, and are bonded. If you need building plans, hire a reputable architect, and make sure they have experience working with cities, and a state license.

- If cost is an issue, hire a reputable designer (a person that can design without a state architect's license).
- Make sure the designer has a current business license, and experience working with cities.

When you are ready to host your Grand Opening, call City Hall to see if a Temporary Use Permit is required. When opening a new business it is important to know who you are leasing from. Don't be pressured to sign a lease right away. Reputable landlords will have consistent pricing that does not expire tomorrow. It is also important that you are allowed to inspect the unit and have access to a floor plan, to ensure it matches what you are seeing. Otherwise, the work may be unpermitted.



## Don't

- Sign a lease without knowing the City's zoning, permits, or building condition.
- Sign a lease prior to getting the City's input regarding the proposed business.
- Start exterior or interior construction work without first checking with the City.
- Make the final payment to a contractor, architect, or designers, until you verify with the City that all work has been completed and is approved.



## Red Flags

- A landlord who doesn't want to sign a lease with a contingency clause.
- A location that says "newly renovated" but there are no permits for the space filed with the City.
- Contractors or anyone who suggests doing work without getting City permits.

# Renew Your Business License for 2025!

As we approach a new year, don't forget to renew your business license. All businesses in the City of Artesia, including companies with transient business activities, must obtain a business license. These businesses might be rental properties, home businesses, contractors, mobile businesses, and 1099 contractors. Licenses are valid for one calendar year, and must be renewed each year. The City is here to help and will automatically send out renewal reminders in December to each existing business operating in the City. Business license renewals are due on January 1st, and late fees apply after January 31st. If you have had a change of ownership, business name, or a new location, be sure to re-apply for your business license. # CO-EXISTING WITH COYOTES

Coyote sightings in City neighborhoods have become increasingly common. While the City does not handle or remove coyotes directly, it does keep track of sightings and encounters. Residents can report coyote sightings through the City's online Service Request system by visiting [www.cityofartesia.us](http://www.cityofartesia.us) and selecting "Report a Concern." For further assistance, sightings and incidents can also be reported to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife at [apps.wildlife.ca.gov/wir](http://apps.wildlife.ca.gov/wir) or by phone at 562-596-3885.

Problem coyotes and incidents should be reported to Los Angeles County Animal Care and Control at 562-940-6898.

Residents are reminded that a few simple actions can help minimize conflicts between residents, pets, and coyotes. If you encounter a coyote, remember to make yourself appear as big as possible and be loud! Stand tall with your arms overhead, hold your ground, and never run. It is crucial not to feed coyotes as this can encourage aggressive behavior. Remove ripe garden vegetables and fallen fruit, and store pet food indoors. Ensure that garbage and compost containers are tightly sealed. Take other preventive measures such as adding motion sensing lighting to deter coyotes. By taking a few simple actions and staying vigilant, we can keep pets, property, and ourselves safe. ## Help Meet Organic Waste Requirements

California law requires every city in the state to establish an organic waste recycling program and ensure compliance. Senate Bill 1383 aims to reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste mainly includes kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape debris and pruning waste.

Both green yard trimmings and kitchen scraps must now be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags are optional and can be purchased from local retailers, but other types of plastic bags are not accepted.

Food scrap pails are available at City Hall to help residents separate food waste. Please visit City Hall to pick one up. The City's waste hauler, CR&R, helps divert organic waste from landfills by converting it into soil amendments at its composting facility.


