

Artesia Recognized by Arbor Day Foundation

TREE CITY USA

The City of Artesia obtained Tree City USA recognition for the third consecutive year by fulfilling all four requirements of the program: maintaining a tree board or department, having a tree care ordinance, dedicating an annual community forestry budget of at least \$2 per capita, and hosting an Arbor Day observance and proclamation. The Tree City USA program is sponsored by the Arbor Day Foundation, in partnership with the U.S. Forest Service and the National Association of State Foresters, to support communities in cultivating and maintaining urban forests. The Chief Executive of the Arbor Day Foundation highlighted the benefits of such initiatives, noting that Artesia's efforts ensure a better quality of life for future generations. Engagement in the program fosters community cohesion and civic pride through volunteerism and public education.

If there was ever a time for trees, now is the time. Communities worldwide are facing challenges like air quality, water resources, health and well-being, energy use, and climate impacts. The City is actively doing its part to tackle these challenges, ensuring a better life for residents now and in the future.

The City emphasizes the importance of a proactive approach to climate change by taking action to protect our environment. By being recognized as a Tree City, Artesia is not just planting trees, we are building and maintaining a healthier future for our community. The City of Artesia will remain dedicated to environmental sustainability and encourages all residents to join in this important initiative.


New Street Improvements Scheduled in Artesia & Cerritos



The City of Artesia and the City of Cerritos have entered into a joint partnership to rehabilitate portions of 195th Street and Flora Vista Street in Artesia as well as Bloomfield Avenue, Norwalk Boulevard, and Del Amo Boulevard in Cerritos. The project will include new pavement and striping, as well as the installation of new safety features to improve walkability and reduce speeding on street sections within the City of Artesia. Affected residents will be noticed prior to construction. Construction in Artesia is slated to begin in July 2025.

City Council Awards Sidewalk Replacement Contract



At its May 12th City Council meeting, the Artesia City Council approved a significant infrastructure contract for a project aimed at improving sidewalk safety and accessibility across the community. Funded through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, the project will repair or replace sidewalks at 39 locations identified in the Citywide Sidewalk Assessment as posing the most serious hazards.

Thanks to the City Council's foresight in joining the County's Revolving Grant Fund, Artesia tripled its FY 2024-25 CDBG allocation from \$90,423 to \$272,472, making this expanded project possible. The City Council awarded the construction contract for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$144,691.85. Work is scheduled to begin this summer and be completed by the fall.

This initiative represents the City's continued commitment to safety and accessibility to all.



Organic Waste Recycling

Every city in California is required to have an organic waste recycling program and comply with other requirements under Senate Bill 1383, to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris. Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics chart. Compostable bags are options and available at local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's contracted waste hauler, will help keep this waste out of the landfills and will convert it into soil amendments at its composting facility.

The City received \$75,000 from CalRecycle for SB 1383 Local Assistance grant funds. This money will be used to enforce and support SB 1383, a law that requires things like recycling organic food waste and improving recycling to reduce pollution. The funds will be used for things like buying containers for organic waste, paying for educational materials, and covering staff time for enforcing SB 1383.

FREE FOOD SCRAPS PAIL

The City of Artesia will provide free kitchen food scraps collection pails to interested residents. This container can be kept in the kitchen to help collect food scraps and used to gather food waste.

This smaller pail can then be emptied into the green organics cart on collection day. Call City Hall at 562-865-6262 to request a pail. One pail per address will be provided. Proof of residency will be required (State I.D. with current address or utility bill).
