Metro's Internship Program (MIP)

The Metro Internship Program, a part of Metro's "Career Ladder Program", offers undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate students an opportunity to gain relevant work experience and job skills through a paid internship.

Eligibility:

- Must be enrolled in 12 units (Undergraduate) or 6 units (Graduate) at an accredited college or university within the U.S.
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (Undergraduate) or 3.0 (Graduate) or higher
- Be a U.S. Citizen or authorized to work in the U.S.
- Interns can work up to 1000 hours per fiscal year (July 1- June 30)
- Pay rate is \$17.87/hour (Undergraduate); \$20.49/hour (Graduate)

Entry-Level Trainee Program (ELTP)

Designed to be an entry-level "Career Ladder Program" for recent college graduates to gain work experience and the job skills needed to seek a full-time position within Metro.

Eligibility:

- Bachelor's degree, or higher, earned within the past two years
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 (Undergraduate) or 3.0 (Graduate) or higher at the time of graduation
- Be a U.S. Citizen or authorized to work in the U.S.
- Participants in ELTP (Transportation Associates) can work up to 40 hours per week
- Pay rate is \$23.26/hour
