September Council Recap

On Monday, September 8th the City Council met to take several key actions. Most significantly, the Council awarded an agreement to RKA Consulting Group to complete plans, specifications and estimates to rehabilitate \$6 million worth of residential roads in the City. The project is expected to kick-off in the Spring of 2026. The Council also approved the schematic design for the Public Service Center which will house the City's Community Development Department, provide local office space for Sheriff's Deputies and house and emergency operations center for the City.
