


# Spring Beautification Award Winners

The Artesia Spring Beautification Awards Program recognizes the efforts of the City's residents and businesses alike to promote sustainability and create beautiful landscapes and storefronts that enhance the attractiveness of the City.

There are four categories of awards: Residential Landscape Beautification, Residential Sustainable Landscape, Business Storefront Beautification, and Business Sustainable Landscape.

The City of Artesia recognized five residences and four businesses as award recipients for the 2025 Spring Beautification Awards. One winner per category is displayed above, with four recipients honored for Residential Landscape Beautification, one for Residential Sustainable Landscape, three for Business Storefront Beautification, and one for Sustainable Landscape.

The Beautification and Maintenance Commission, who promotes the City's efforts to maintain Artesia as an attractive community, serves as the judging committee for this program. The Beautification Program will resume in Spring 2026.

## ARTESIA CLEAN Bulky Item Drop Off

ONE CURB AT A TIME.

### Saturday, October 11 9AM-12PM

The final bulky item drop-off of the year is scheduled for October 11th from 9 am to 12 noon at A.J. Padelford Park, located at 11870 169th Street, Artesia CA, 90701. The City partners with its contracted waste hauler, CR7R, to provide this service, and Artesia residents can take advantage of up to four free bulky item drop-off events each year, helping to keep Artesia clean.

Residents are encouraged to bring old mattresses, patio furniture, appliances, electronic waste, and other large items for free disposal. Elderly and disabled residents can request a special pick-up for certain items.

The event is first-come first-served, and residents are welcome to make repeated trips to dispose of unwanted bulky items. For further details, please contact City Hall at 562-865-6262 ext. 200.



# Organic Waste Recycling

Every city in California is required to have an organic waste recycling program and comply with other requirements under Senate Bill 1383, to help reduce emissions of short-lived climate pollutants. Organic waste consists mainly of kitchen food scraps and yard trimmings, such as landscape and pruning debris. Green yard trimmings and kitchen food scraps must now both be recycled in the green organics cart. Compostable bags are options and available at local retailers. Other types of plastic bags are not accepted. CR&R Environmental Services (CR&R), the City's contracted waste hauler, will help keep this waste out of the landfills and will convert it into soil amendments at its composting facility.

The City received \$75,000 from CalRecycle for SB 1383 Local Assistance grant funds. This money will be used to enforce and support SB 1383, a law that requires things like recycling organic food waste and improving recycling to reduce pollution. The funds will be used for things like buying containers for organic waste, paying for educational materials, and covering staff time for enforcing SB 1383.

## FREE FOOD SCRAPS PAIL

The City of Artesia will provide free kitchen food scraps collection pails to interested residents. This container can be kept in the kitchen to help collect food scraps and used to gather food waste.

This smaller pail can then be emptied into the green organics cart on collection day. Call City Hall at 562-865-6262 to request a pail. One pail per address will be provided. Proof of residency will be required (State I.D. with current address or utility bill).




