October Council Recap

On Monday, October 13, the City Council met to take several key actions. The Council adopted a Resolution of Intention to form an Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District (EIFD), which will provide a new local funding tool to support long-term infrastructure improvements such as the highspeed rail, first-last-mile infrastructure, and roads without any new fees or taxes. The Council also approved an amendment to the funding policy for the Community Benefits Grant Program which opens later this week. The meeting also included special proclamations recognizing Breast Cancer Awareness Month, Filipino American History Month, Hindu Heritage Month, and Red Ribbon Week, and National Code Enforcement Appreciation Month honoring the many contributions and causes important to the Artesia community. 



Celebrate Adopt a Shelter Dog Month with "Read to Rover"

Throughout the entire month of October, the Los Angeles County Department of Animal Care and Control (DACC) is offering a special "Read to Rover" promotion at all animal care centers. When you read a book to any DACC dog, your adoption fee will be waived the same day, including spay/neuter and microchip services. A UC Davis study found that kids who read just 15-20 minutes a week to shelter dogs improved their reading fluency by 30%. It's a great way to share a story, make a connection, and give a shelter dog a forever home!
