Artesia Awarded \$430,005 to Send Local Youth on a Great California Adventure

The City of Artesia has been awarded a \$430,005 Youth Community Access Grant from the California Natural Resources Agency to launch the Artesia Great Adventure Program, a new 15-month initiative connecting local youth with California's natural and cultural resources. The program will serve over 1,200 participants ages 8-18 through trips and seasonal camps focused on outdoor exploration, environmental education, and conservation. Programming is expected to begin in 2026 and run through March 2027.
